- 1. The name of the Society will be 'QUALITY COUNCIL OF INDIA'.
- 2. The Registered Office of the Society will be situated in the National Capital Territory of Delhi. It will, for the time being, be situated in Institution of Engineers Building, ITO, New Delhi.
- 3. The Society will function as an autonomous body based within the territory of India and, if necessary, may obtain mutual recognition with other bodies operating similar accreditation schemes in other countries/regions through bilateral/multilateral arrangements.

- b) to purchase, to take on lease, accept as gift or otherwise acquire any land or building wherever situated in India which may be necessary or convenient for the society;
- c) to construct or alter any building which may be necessary for the society;
- d) to publish books, literature and periodicals to inculcate quality consciousness amongst industries and the people of the country;
- e) to raise or acquire funds or property from Central Govt. and State Govts., foreign agencies, non-governmental agencies or by taking loans from public and private financial institutions. The funds, properties, assets and all other resources present and future, of the society shall be utilized for any or all the purposes or objects of the society as stated above and also other similar activities;
- f) to invest the funds of aloney entrusted to the society upon such securities or in such manner as that, from time, be determined by the governing body or transpose such investments;
- g) to do all such other lawful things as are incidental or conducive to attainment of any or all the above objects.

The income and property of the society, however derived, shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects thereof as set out in this Memorandum of Association. No

ion of the income and property of the society shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by with of dividends, bonus or otherwise, by way of profits to the persons who at any time are or have been members of the society or to any of them, or to any person claiming through them, or any of them, provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith or remuneration to any member thereof or other persons in return for any service rendered to the society.
