Guidelines for Authors

General:

The manuscript should be submitted in Microsoft Word with following guidelines:

- ❖ The papers should be in English, formatted for A4 size with 1.15 spacing and with a margin of at least 1.8 cm all around
- ❖ Fonts: Times New Roman
- ❖ Font Size: Headings- 14 size bold, all other text- 12 size normal text
- ❖ Line Spacing: 1.5 within a paragraph, allow extra space between paragraphs
- ❖ DO NOT add headers, footers, or page numbers
- ❖ The maximum preferred length for original papers is 8 pages (including figures and tables).

Structure:

All submissions should essentially include the following, in the sequential order:

- ❖ The title should be of no more than 20 words (bold, 14 font size, center alignment, Times New Roman) of the paper that describes the content succinctly;
- ❖ Names of the authors: (normal text, 12 font size, center alignment, Times New Roman), separated by comma (,); their affiliation and address
- ❖ Abstract: Should not be more than 1000 words
- ❖ Keywords: Provide 4-7 suitable keywords

Main Text:

For the main body of the text, there are no specific requirements. It may be organized in a way that best suits the research. However, the following structure will be suitable in many cases:

- Introduction
- Literature review, if any
- Research methods
- Data analysis & interpretation, if any
- Result Discussions
- Research implications
- Conclusion
- Acknowledgments, if any

References:

Use APA citation style, list the references in alphabetical order by authors' last names; include first and middle initials for all authors. If there are two or more items by the same author(s), list them in order of year of publication. All references cited in the text must be listed in the reference section, and vice versa.

Abbreviations:

Abbreviated terms should be spelt out at first use and followed with the abbreviation in parentheses.

Tables and figures:

Each table and figure should be numbered consecutively throughout the text and placed at appropriate places

Note:

- Preferable number of author is one (01).
- Last date for acceptance of the Monographs: 31st January 2022
