Incorporating this requirement will not only ensure the project's adherence to international quality standards but also instill confidence among all stakeholders involved. It is worth noting that the mentioned CMMI Level 3 certification pertains to development organizations and activities, which is not applicable in the context of this project focused</p> <p>on testing laboratories. Regarding the technical evaluation parameters, we propose a revision in the marks distribution to emphasize the importance of organizational certifications, particularly ISO 17025:2017. We suggest the following allocation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 marks for ISO 17025:2017 certification, underscoring its significance in ensuring the laboratory's capability to produce precise and reliable test and calibration results. • 3 marks for ISO 9001 and ISO 27001 certifications, recognizing their value in quality management and information security, respectively. • 0 marks for organizations without any leading industry certifications, highlighting the necessity of such certifications in maintaining the project's integrity and quality.
